A few expanded remarks on survey question answers:

#2: I am open to listening to proposals given there are casinos already present in North Carolina from areas who are interested in pursuing this that are not on tribal-enforcement land. There would need to be explanations of how they would avoid exploitation of the poor, ban participation of minors, distance from schools, etc. I am a lean to "No," but I am willing to listen to proposals from North Carolina communities.

#3: I am in favor of exceptions being made for rape/incest as well as lethal fetal anomalies. There would also have to be exceptions for endangered life of the mother in PRE-VIABLE gestational age pregnancies only.

#4: If a business received incentives to locate to NC, there would have to be clear explanations on how the vast majority of benefits would go to residents ALREADY LIVING in the area. If a company receives incentives, they cannot simply import their own workforce and not allow residents of the community to reap the opportunities. This would include businesses supporting training efforts of area residents to gain the skills necessary to obtain higher paying jobs. There would also have to be measurable outcomes for community benefit that, if not met, would require the return of incentives received by the business.
